
#### Introduction...

- Our Lord, God and Creator, Jesus Christ came into Human form to achieve two key things.
- He became the Last Adam for these two reasons:
- 1 To Save the whole Human race from SIN and from sin
- 2 To start a whole new human race who will have Eternal Life and thus fulfil the original plan that God had with Adam before the FALL.



#### Introduction...

- <sup>22</sup> Then the LORD God said, "Behold, the man has become like one of Us, to know good and evil.
- And now, lest he put out his hand and take also of <u>the tree of life, and eat</u>, <u>and live forever"—</u>
- <sup>23</sup> therefore the LORD God sent him out of the garden of Eden to till the ground from which he was taken.
- <sup>24</sup> So He drove out the man; and He placed cherubim at the east of the garden of Eden, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to guard the way to <u>the tree of life</u>.



## The Earth...

- The original plan of God was and is to raise 'Sons' (male & female) for His Glory.
- The reason why God created the Earth in the first place can be seen in scripture:
- The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD's; But the earth He has given to the children of men. Ps 115:16



#### The Earth...

- The original plan for Adam remains:
- <sup>26</sup> Then God said, "Let Us make man <u>in Our image</u>, <u>according to Our likeness</u>;
- let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, <u>over all the earth</u> and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."
- <sup>27</sup> <u>So God created man in His own image</u>; in the image of God, He created him; male and female He created them.
- <sup>28</sup> Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; <u>fill the earth</u> and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth." Genesis 1:26-28



#### New Earth...

- Now I saw a new heaven and <u>a new earth</u>, for the first heaven and the <u>first earth had passed away</u>.
  Also, there was no more sea.
- <sup>2</sup>Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.
- <sup>3</sup> And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of <u>God is with men</u>, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. <u>God Himself will be with them</u> and be their God.
- <sup>4</sup>And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away."
- <sup>5</sup>Then He who sat on the throne said, <u>"Behold, I</u> <u>make all things new.</u>" And He said to me, "Write, for these words are true and faithful. Revelation 21:1-5



#### New Earth...

 "For behold, I create new heavens and a <u>new earth</u>; And <u>the former shall not be remembered</u>

or come to mind.

- <sup>18</sup> But be glad and rejoice forever in what I create;
  For behold, I create Jerusalem as a rejoicing, And her people a joy.
- <sup>19</sup> I will rejoice in Jerusalem, And joy in My people; The voice of weeping shall no longer be heard in her, Nor the voice of crying.

Isaiah 65:17-19



## The Kingdom..

- Jesus as the Last Adam came to 'RESET' everything back to the original plan. Back to 'Factory Settings'.
- That is why His message was not 'come to Church' but ENTER the Kingdom of God.
- "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is <u>born again</u>, he cannot see the kingdom of God." John 3:3



## The Kingdom

- <sup>17</sup> From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, "Repent, for the <u>kingdom of heaven</u> is at hand." Matthew 3:17
- <sup>14</sup> Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came to Galilee, preaching the gospel of <u>the kingdom of God</u>,
- <sup>15</sup> and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and <u>the kingdom of God</u> is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel." Mark 1:14-15



#### Follow...

- <sup>16</sup> And as He walked by the Sea of Galilee, He saw Simon and Andrew his brother casting a net into the sea;
- for they were fishermen. <sup>17</sup> Then Jesus said to them,
- *"Follow Me, and I will make you become fishers of men."*
- <sup>18</sup> They immediately left their nets and followed Him Mark 1:16-18

- Galatians 4:19




#### Formed...


## In His Image...

- The key feature in encountering Christ is that He becomes DUPLICATED within us...
- This is the essence of salvation.
- ...let us MAKE man in our IMAGE
- ....after our LIKENESS



#### Replicate....

- ....to be conformed to the <u>image</u> of His Son....
- This is the focus and aim of the Gospel of Christ.
- The original aim of God was to raise up a race of mankind after the LIKENESS and IMAGE of Christ who is GOD.



#### Grow Up...

- This work must continue until we are all joined together in what we believe and in what we know about the Son of God.
- Our goal is to become like a fullgrown man—<u>to look just like</u> <u>Christ</u> and have all his perfection. Ephesians 4:13



#### Become....

- But <u>put on the Lord Jesus Christ</u>, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts. Romans 13:14
- And put on the new nature (the regenerate self) <u>created in God's</u> <u>image</u>, [Godlike] in true righteousness and holiness. Ephesians 4:24




#### Becoming...
