


Introduction...

Introduction...

- 12 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:
- 13 who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. John 1:12
- Tonight, we explore what Jesus did for us at the CROSS. We are revisiting a study we did last year. So, we will explore this a bit further in this study.



- When you meet Jesus something amazing happens to you:
- YOU COME ALIVE!!
- "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. ³⁸ He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.

 John 7:38
- When you meet Jesus and believe in Him, you are renewed spiritually.




- When you accept Jesus' sacrifice on the cross, you receive a <u>new identity</u>. You are no longer defined by your past sins but by your relationship with Christ.
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 says, "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!"
- Romans 6:6-7 states, "For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body ruled by sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin—because anyone who has died has been set free from sin."




- There was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews. ² This man came to Jesus by night and said to Him,
- "Rabbi, we know that You are a teacher come from God; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him."
- ³ Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, <u>unless</u> <u>one is born again</u>, he cannot see the kingdom of God."
- 4 Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?"
- ⁵ Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, <u>unless one is born of</u> <u>water and the Spirit</u>, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.
- ⁶ That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.
- John 3:1-6



- Through the cross, believers receive the Holy Spirit, who empowers them to live righteously.
- The Holy Spirit convicts of sin, guides in truth, and provides strength to resist temptation.
- Galatians 5:16 says, "So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh."
- Romans 8:11 explains, "And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of his Spirit who lives in you."



- The cross signifies not only Jesus' death but also His resurrection, symbolizing victory over sin and death. Believers are united with Christ in both His death and resurrection.
- Romans 6:4 states, "We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life."
- Colossians 3:1-3 reminds us, "Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.
- Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God."



- ¹³ Jesus answered and said to her, "Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again,
- 14 but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life."
 John 4:13-14





SPIRIT...

- ²³ But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth;
- for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. ²⁴ <u>God is Spirit,</u> and those who worship Him must worship <u>in spirit</u> and truth."

 John 4:24
- Those who come to Jesus come in contact with the essence of LIFE. He emanates LIFE and dispenses LIFE to all who believe in Him.
- If God is SPIRIT, then those who are Born of God are SPIRIT too.

SPIRIT...

- ²⁶ I will give you a new heart and put <u>a</u>
 new spirit within you; I will take the
 heart of stone out of your flesh and
 give you a heart of flesh.
- ²⁷ I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do *them*.

- having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise,




ALIVE...


1 Peter 1:23

- Jesus said to her, "Did I not say to you that if you would believe you would see the glory of God?" ⁴¹ Then they took away the stone from the place where the dead man was lying.
- And Jesus lifted up His eyes and said, "Father, I thank You that You have heard, Me. ⁴² And I know that You always hear Me, but because of the people who are standing by I said this, that they may believe that You sent Me."
- ⁴³ Now when He had said these things, He cried with a loud voice,
- "Lazarus, come forth!"
- ⁴⁴ And he who had died came out bound hand and foot with graveclothes, and his face was wrapped with a cloth. Jesus said to them, "Loose him, and let him go." John 11:40-44




- Followers of Jesus are followers of Life.

- Jesus is the essence of LIFE.




LIFE

JESUS...LIFE

- Now it happened, the day after, that He went into a city called Nain;
 and many of His disciples went with Him, and a large crowd.
- 12 And when He came near the gate of the city, behold, <u>a dead man</u> was being carried out, the only son of his mother; and she was a widow. And a large crowd from the city was with her.
- 13 When the Lord saw her, He had compassion on her and said to her, "Do not weep."
- 14 Then He came and touched the open coffin, and those who carried him stood still. And He said, "Young man, I say to you, arise."
- 15 So <u>he who was dead sat up and began to speak.</u> And He presented him to his mother.






 "Most assuredly, I say to you, the hour is coming, and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God; and those who hear will live.
